

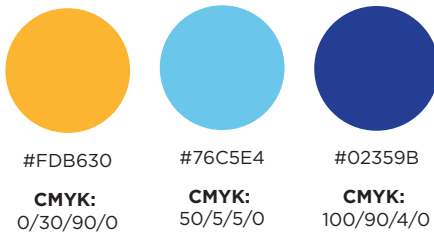

### PRIMARY COLOR PALETTE



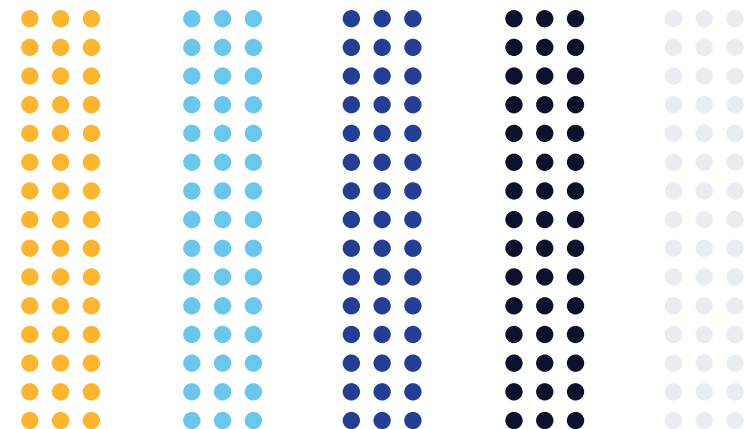
### ACCENT COLORS
